Dear Nikki Reynolds:

On behalf of the NITLE Eastern Advisory Council, I am writing to inform you that the Council is pleased to award Hamilton College with \$45,000 to implement "The Moving Images Collaborative." Per the guidelines of the Instructional Innovation Fund, the award is being made to the proposing group's lead institution. Hamilton College will provide all information and administrative support for the project. This IIF program runs through June 2008. Work supported by awards must be completed and reports submitted by June 30, 2009. You should note that at the conclusion of the planning process unused funds must be returned to NITLE.

The Council expressed strong support for the proposal, which it viewed as demonstrating intent to engage in the types of projects and programs that the Council desires to see implemented. Further, the Council appreciated the open-ended commitment to this initiative on the part of the collaborating institutions. The participating institutions and principal participants in the project represent a valuable and diverse array of roles and disciplines, and the interdisciplinary collaborations reflected in the proposal also represent an objective of the Advisory Council. In addition, the structure of the "participant observers" charged with dissemination is a valuable component of this proposal.

In general, the Council viewed the proposal as well-constructed and exemplifying the work that it anticipates supporting in the context of the NITLE Instructional Innovation Fund.
